The Doomben 10,000 is a \$1,500,000 Group 1 WFA race over 1200m.at Doomben

But it was not always ...

It fact last year it was run at Eagle Farm.

The race was first run in 1933 over six furlongs. It was then changed to 7 furlongs in 1942 and became a 1350m race in 1972. In 2017 in reverted back to 1200m.

The 10,000 name came from the early prizemoney of 10,000 pounds and was once known and the richest sprint race in Australia.

Sydney trainers have dominated in recent years with Tony Gollan winning the race with Spirit of Boom back in 2014. Since 2011 Peter Snowden has won the race four times.
