Derby Day

At this corresponding time last year I made the point that racing at Flemington always seems to throw up long priced winners. Well it happened again last Saturday at Flemington with Vongole winning at \$51. The 7 year old was beaten by 9.1 lengths at its last start and previously had only won up to BM 70 grade. It was a BM 90 grade last week, but stormed home to win from 11th at the 400m to win like a champion.

The carnival crosses the road this week to Eagle Farm and the running of the Queensland Derby, one of oldest feature races on the calendar. It was actually first run in1868 in Gayndah.

Previous Derby winners include Tulloch, Kingston Town, Strawberry Road, Rough Habit and Freemason. A horse called Lawn Mower also won in 1921.

Shocking ran second in the Queensland Derby in 2009 before going on to win the Melbourne Cup later that year and I still remember being right in the middle of the bookies ring in 1997 when Yippyio beat Marble Halls.
