Makybe Diva Stakes

The Makybe Diva Stakes is a Group 1 race held at WFA conditions over 1600m at Flemington.

It was previously known as the Craiglee Stakes.



Past winners include Comic Court, Light Fingers, Tobin Bronze, Family of Man, Dulcify, Jeune, Sky Heights, Northerly, Shocking and Fawkner.

Fun fact though is that even though the race is now named after Makybe Diva, she actually never won or even ran in the race. In the lead up to the 2003 Melbourne Cup, Makybe Diva came 4th in the Turnbull and 4th in the Caulfield Cup

In 2004, Makybe Diva went 4th in the Memsie, 2nd Feehan, 2nd Turnbull and won the Caulfield Cup before winning the Melbourne Cup.

Finally, in 2005, her campaign went 1st Memsie, 2nd Feehan, 1st Turnbull, 1st Cox Plate and then, of course, a third win the Melbourne Cup.

Melbourne Cup, 2005

One of my greatest memories was going to Melbourne in 2005 for the Melbourne Cup.

I was super confident that Makybe Diva was going to make it three in a row, and I saw odds around \$4.20 with Bookies before the race.

I had \$170 left and put \$50 on her to win, keeping \$120 spare because I had promised myself I was going to box 6 horses for the trifecta for \$120.

I was under pressure and threw all form out the window and asked the other five people I was with to give me a number each. They picked 4,7,8,10,16.

I added 1 and quickly boxed it. Boom! Not only did she win her third Melbourne Cup in a row, but 1,16,8 was the trifecta paying \$4951.70.

Needless to say I shouted everyone that evening and we had just the best Melbourne Cup day.
