Winning Ways

Female jockeys have had much success in recent years and last Saturday at Randwick there was a little bit of history made.

For the first time ever, female jockeys rode Group 1 winners on the same program with Kathy O'Hara giving Rediener a superb ride and in the very next race Rachel King won the Metropolitan in a cracking finish on Just Fine.

It was the third Group 1 winner for O'Hara following Ofcourseyoucan (2012 Coolmore) and Single Gaze (2016 Vinery Stud Stakes).

For King it was her fourth Group 1 following Maid of Heaven (2018 Spring Champion Stakes); Knights Order (2022 Sydney Cup) and Arapaho (2023 Tancred Stakes).

For those that like their history, Diane Moseley was the first female to win a Group 1 in Australia on Double You Em in the 1982 Doomben Cup.

Adding to the female dominance, Gai Waterhouse (in partnership with Adrian Bott) trained four winners on the card, including the trifecta in the Breeders' Plate a feat that also hadn't been done before.

There are also a number of up and coming female apprentices who have had a great month in the saddle. Worth paying attention to Emily Lang (SEQ and Northern Rivers) when she rides for Pat Webster; Gabrielle Semmens (North Queensland) riding for Tom Button and Brooke Johnson (Emerald region) when she is riding for Jennifer Hatfield or Nick Walsh.
